## PLAN OF DISSEMINATION

- (c) The Notice of Certification and Settlement Approval Hearing will be published once in the following newspapers, in either English or French, as is appropriate for each newspaper, subject to each having reasonable publication deadlines and costs:
  - (i) The Globe and Mail, national edition;
  - (ii) The Vancouver Sun;
  - (iii) Journal de Montreal;
  - (iv) Regina Leader Post;
  - (v) Calgary Herald;
  - (vi) Winnipeg Free Press;
  - (vii) Halifax Chronicle Herald;
  - (viii) StarPhoenix (Saskatoon);
    - (ix) Le Soleil (Quebec City); and
    - (x) National Post.
- 2. The costs of distributing the Notice of Certification and Settlement Approval Hearing shall be paid from the Settlement Amount.
